
What do we do?


We contact the parents of every baby born in Fulton County to offer a home visit by a Public Health Nurse. A Public Health Nurse (PHN) is a RN with at least a 4-year college degree in Nursing and additional skills in caring for mothers and children. Public Health Nurses are experienced in caring for people in their own homes.



**What will the
Public Health
Nurse do?**

The PHN will call you within a few days of your discharge from the hospital to ask how you and your baby are doing and answer any questions you may have. If you wish, she will come to your home to see you and your baby. She will bring information that covers many topics of baby and child care, will weigh your baby, and will demonstrate any baby care techniques you may not be sure of, like taking a temperature.





Why did you choose me?

Whether it is your first baby or your seventh, we contact every Mom we can. Since each baby is an individual, your new baby may not look like or act like your other children. Immunization schedules, and childcare recommendations seem to change all of the time. Breastfeeding is the best way to feed your baby, but it can be challenging.

Our Nurses see babies every day, and can help you to feel confident that the care you are giving your little one is the best you can give.

What else can you do for me?

We are concerned about families!

We also offer services for older children and adults. We provide some health services at our clinics, such as dental care, and immunizations at minimal cost to families with limited incomes. If your baby has special needs, our Early Intervention program will provide services designed to help your child reach its full potential. With your permission, we can link you to other community services, such as WIC that can help you to meet your family's needs. We can also give your information about Child Health Plus, a free or low cost health insurance program for children who are eligible.
