reduce their trash disposal fees.

Fulton County and New York State
garbage hauler should offer the op-
portunity to recycling separate from regular
waste. DSW also offers businesses the
ability to bring their own recyclables and avoid
paying disposal fees.

Waste Recycling Program offered
by the County Dept. of Solid Waste. For a
one-time fee, a small business can drop
off (garbage) all year, at \$40/ton. The
program is designed with any vehicle, and no special
equipment is needed.

Other Business Friendly Programs

Electronics Disposal Program

Small businesses and non-profits can dispose of elec-
tronics at the Solid Waste Department on Mud Road.
There is no charge and no permit is needed, but please
call ahead for large amounts. This includes computers,
monitors, keyboards, scanners, printers, cell phones,
televisions, and other electronic products.

Mercury Containing Thermostats

Mercury-Containing Thermostats (*non-digital*) can be
disposed of at the Solid Waste Department on Mud
Road. This program is open to all county residents,
contractors, and businesses. There is no charge and no
permit is needed.

*There are also several special categories that are
targeted toward businesses - but must be hauled by
a permitted commercial hauler. These include:*

Compost

There is a \$10/ton charge for disposal of brush,
branches or limbs generated in Fulton County.

Clean Fill & Clean Wood

These are special non-residential disposal categories
for construction and demolition debris, as well as
clean wood products, which will qualify for LEED
certification that calls for recycling. Clean Wood ma-
terials generated in Fulton County are \$10/ton; Out-of-
County Clean Wood is \$25/ton. In-County Clean Fill
materials are no cost; Out-Of-County is \$25/ton.
Clean Fill categories must be pre-approved.

- **Clean Fill** includes: Construction & Demolition
Debris, Concrete (*no metal*), Asphalt Pavement,
Bricks, and Rocks.
- **Clean Wood** includes: Tree Parts, Brush, Pallets
(*no nails*), and Non-Painted Lumber. No Stumps.

REDUCE ♦ REUSE ♦ RECYCLE

Recycling is charged \$40 per ton. A Small Business Recycling Permit can be purchased for \$25/year. This is for **Recycling Only**, (no garbage) prepared as below. Call 518-736-5504 for a Small Business Recycling Permit, or download at www.fultoncountyny.gov/dsw

For Singlestream Recyclables

1. All recyclable items – paper, cardboard, plastic, metal and glass containers – can be mixed together - No Sorting or Separation Is Needed
2. Lids and labels can be left on recyclable containers, which should be empty and rinsed before recycling.
3. Recyclables will have to be dumped loose at the Recycling Facility. No string, no bags, no trash allowed. (*shredded paper is the only recycling item accepted in a plastic bag*).
4. Corrugated Cardboard should be flattened. It can be brought in bulk.

- Newspaper & Inserts
- Junk Mail, Circulars, Magazines & Catalogs
- Phonebooks & Paperbacks
- Brown Grocery Bags
- Lightweight & Corrugated Cardboard (flattened)
- Beverage Cartons (Milk, Juice & Juice boxes)



PIZZA BOXES AND MILK & JUICE CARTONS CAN NOW BE INCLUDED IN RECYCLING!

DO NOT INCLUDE

Hardcover books,
Paper plates,
Napkins, Tissues,
Construction paper,
Tissue paper,
Soda & Beer Cartons

ONE EXCEPTION TO THE "NO BAG" RULE: SHREDDED PAPER – Tie up in a clear plastic bag. Put with loose recyclables.

PLASTIC

- Plastic Bottles & Containers
Number Codes 1-5, some 7
- Milk & Water Jugs
- Cottage Cheese, Yogurt & Pudding Cup Containers
- Soap & Detergent Containers



DO NOT INCLUDE

Toys, Plastic bags,
Styrofoam containers,
Motor oil bottles,
Clothes hangers,
pill bottles

METAL

- Food & Beverage Cans
- Deposit Cans
- Aluminum Plates & Trays
- Aluminum Foil (clean)
- Aerosol Cans (empty)
- Metal Lids



DO NOT INCLUDE

Metal-cardboard containers
(like a cocoa box), Pans,
Clothes hangers, Silverware,
Small appliances

GLASS

- Clear, Green & Amber Containers
- Food & Beverage Containers
- Canning Jars
- Deposit Bottles
- Liquor & Wine Bottles



DO NOT INCLUDE

Broken glass,
Drinking glasses,
Dishes, Ovenware,
Ceramics, Mirrors,
Window glass,
Light bulbs
