

SINGLESTREAM RECYCLING, HOW IT WORKS

All Recyclable Items Mix Together in One Bin for Collection!

1. All recyclable items—paper, cardboard, plastic, metal and glass—need to be mixed together loosely in one bin.
2. Lids and labels can be left on recyclable containers, which should be empty and rinsed before recycling.
3. Recyclables must be placed in your designated recycling bin (a durable, lidded, plastic or metal container of your choice, (45 gallon maximum), 50lb limit, marked with a recycling sticker. More than one recycling bin is OK. No private waste companies' bins allowed.
4. Do not place recyclables in plastic bags for collection (shredded paper is the only exception). No strings, no bags, no trash allowed.
5. Carboard boxes must be empty (packaging removed) and flattened/broken down before recycling.

Remember the ONLY exception to the "NO BAG" RULE: SHREDDED PAPER. Tie up in a clear plastic bag. Put the bag in with loose recyclables.

Hardcover books, Paper plates, Napkins, Tissues, Construction paper, Diapers, Tissue Paper, Soda & Beer Cartons & Freezer Food Boxes

STOP

NOT ACCEPTED!

Styrofoam of any kind, Plastic bags, Motor oil bottles, Clothes hangers, Toys, Prescription pill bottles, Laundry baskets, plastic bags & plastic film

STOP

NOT ACCEPTED!

Metal-cardboard containers (cocoa can), Clothes hangers, Silverware, Pans, small appliances, automotive parts, Pesticides, or Paint cans

STOP

NOT ACCEPTED!

Broken glass, Drinking glasses, Ovenware or ceramics, Dishes, Mirrors, Window glass, vases or light bulbs
