On January 2, 2025, in the absence of former President Robert Galinsky, Commissioner William Eschler at 11:15AM called a meeting for organizing as a Board as required by election Law 3-212, at the Fulton County Board of Elections office. Those in attendance; William Eschler – Republican Commissioner, Cinda Spraker – Republican Deputy Commissioner and Cheyenna Malagisi – Republican Election Clerk, Robin Wentworth – newly appointed Democratic Commissioner, Rebecca Weiderman – Democratic Deputy Commissioner and Joy Beekman – Democratic Election Clerk.

In keeping with tradition, the 1 year terms of President and Secretary positions were changed. Commissioner Eschler was named President and Commissioner Wentworth was named Secretary for 2025.

The Commissioners appointed their staff for the 2-year term, 2025-2026. Commissioner Eschler re-appointed Cinda Spraker – Republican Deputy Commissioner and Cheyenna Malagisi – Republican Election Clerk. Commissioner Wentworth re-appointed Rebecca Weiderman – Democratic Deputy Commissioner and Joy Beekman – Democratic Election Clerk.

Also re-appointed for the 2-year terms were Election Machine Technicians Greg Niforos and Jeff Nasadoski.

Election inspector training will be held in September at the Fulton County Board of Elections office.

There was some discussion regarding the upcoming special election for the 21st Congressional District seat that is anticipated to be vacated. There could be a possible

conflict with the local school elections due to the number of voting machines available. Possible solutions discussed included combining smaller voting districts or schools utilizing paper ballots.

There was also discussion about needing to have moving companies submit an RFP for moving voting machines to and from voting sites when needed.
