Serves Broadalbin Village and Town Residents.
Permit Required from Town Clerk

Permit Stickers Valid 7/1 – 6/30 Annually. Check
with Town Clerk for pricing.

General Transfer Station Information

This station accepts: garbage, Single Stream recycling, bulk metal, textiles, used motor oil, vehicle and rechargeable batteries and electronics (computers, monitors & TVs). No additional charge.

5' x 8' is the MAXIMUM size for trailers. Dump trucks/trailers not allowed.

Items below must come to the Department of Solid Waste at 847 Mud Road, Johnstown ONLY:

- Freon containing units (refrigerators, freezers, air conditioners and dehumidifiers). \$5 each
- Fluorescent light bulbs or tubes. No Charge
- Mercury-containing thermostats. No Charge
- Household Hazardous Waste. (ODD Years in August). Watch for announcement. No Charge
- Tires (off the rim): \$3.00 up to 16"; \$5 for tires 16.5" - 21"; \$13 for tires 21.5" - 24"; bulk tires (20 or more) or tires over 24.5" \$350/ton

There is no charge for appliances
